Student Internship Opportunity

Quest Corporation of America is seeking a candidate for a three-month student internship position within its rapidly growing video services division. Location of the internship will be primarily at the Quest Corporate office located at 17220 Camelot Court, Land O' Lakes, FL 34638.

The ideal candidate should possess a background in and/or is currently pursuing a post-secondary education career in multimedia, video production, photography, marketing, public relations, or other related fields. Prior experience and familiarity with video production, photography, video editing, graphic design disciplines are highly desired, but not required as there will be substantial training throughout the internship.

The rate for this position is \$10/hour and will average between 20 to 30 hours a week depending on workload, not to exceed 40 hours in a single week. Hours worked will typically adhere to Quest's business hours of 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. (with an hour lunch) but may occasionally occur on evenings, weekends, and other non-business times. Advance notice of expected hourly commitments will be given to the intern on a weekly basis. The intern will report directly to Quest's Video Services Program Manager, Tomás Monzón.

Quest's goal with this internship is to expose the ideal candidate to the world of multimedia production for public and private clients. Interns will receive hands-on training on the use of multimedia equipment such as professional cameras, camcorders and industry-standard graphic design and video editing software such as Adobe Premiere and Adobe After Effects. Interns will also assist in the execution of client-driven video projects from start to finish, including but not limited to scripting, storyboarding, meeting with clients, shooting, editing, reviewing and more. Quest seeks to provide the ideal candidate with valuable knowledge and experience regarding the world of multimedia production as well as transferable skills such as time management, customer relations, collaborating with others and more.

The list below is a summary of duties the video intern may be expected to participate in, assist with, or take lead on:

1. Taking headshots of Quest associates.
2. Framing shots using photo and video cameras.
3. Transferring data from cameras to editing computers for post-production and distribution.
4. Assisting on video and photo shoots in the field (transportation will be provided and/or arranged accordingly).
5. Participating in brainstorming sessions for new projects.
6. Interacting with Quest associates on video-related services.
7. Maintaining the video studio in good working order.
8. Editing pre-recorded video footage, audio files and photographs.
9. Adding special visual and aural effects to pre-recorded video footage, audio files and photographs.
